Killer robot prohibition discussed in Geneva

International representatives started a weapons conference for 2 days to discuss the restriction of the development of "killer robots" in Geneva.

These weapons are designed to automatically select targets and kill people. It was the first time for "killer robots" to be discussed at the Convention on Certain Conventional Weapons.

Before the conference, a human-rights group representative stated that it is ethically and morally wrong to allow machines to judge a person's life or death, and observers all over the world wanted these weapons to be prohibited.

The chair of the conference, the ambassador of France, proposed that a group of experts should gather next year to discuss the weapon in terms of legal and technical matters with the view of creating a ban.

The participants are expected to include the launching of the experts' panel, since many of the participants at the conference expressed their support for the proposal of France. U.S. has already given its favor of using the robots for military purposes but it indicates the support for further discussions.
